Dear Delton-Kellogg Families and Staff,

On Thursday, April 27, at approximately 10:00 pm, District administration was made aware of a potential threat to school safety. The threat was rumored to involve a student and scheduled to take place at a school building.

Upon learning of this threat, District administration immediately contacted the Barry County Sheriff's Department, as well as the Michigan State Police, and an investigation was conducted overnight, including interviews with the student.

The Sheriff's Department, after concluding its diligent investigation, determined that the threat was not credible and that school may resume. As a result, classes and normal school operations are taking place today, Friday, April 28.

Please know that the safety of our children and staff remains of paramount importance to the District, and we take threats to school safety seriously.
